At Kings Furlong Junior School, our vision is built on four core values: **Belong, Believe, Aspire, Achieve**. These values shape our culture, guide our decisions, and inspire our learning community every day.

We believe that when children belong, they feel safe, valued, and connected. When they believe in themselves and their potential, they grow in confidence and resilience. When they aspire, they dream big and strive to improve. And when they are supported to achieve, they experience success and develop a lifelong love of learning.

Our class names reflect the learning behaviours we nurture in every child: **respect, resilience, reflection, curiosity, creativity, teamwork, risk-taking, responsibility**, alongside our core values. These behaviours help children become thoughtful, independent learners who are ready to face the future with confidence.



What role do you play?

BELONG

- ▶ Encourage participation in school events, extra curricular activities, and clubs to help children feel connected.
- ▶ Model inclusivity at home — promote respect for others, talk positively about differences, and support friendships with a diverse range of peers.
- ▶ Build relationships with adults in the school community and other families to create a strong support network.
- ▶ Create routines that show school is a valued and safe place to be.

BELIEVE

- ▶ Nurture confidence and a positive mindset
- ▶ Express belief in your child's potential — praise effort, not just outcomes.
- ▶ Help them overcome self-doubt by talking through challenges and celebrating progress.
- ▶ Share stories of resilience (your own or others) to show that setbacks are part of learning.
- ▶ Work with us so we can support your child in areas where they struggle.

ASPIRE

- ▶ Encourage goal-setting and big dreams
- ▶ Talk about the future positively — ask about their ambitions and encourage exploration of interests.
- ▶ Expose them to role models — from books, community, or your own life — who show what's possible with effort.
- ▶ Set shared goals (academic and personal) and track progress together.
- ▶ Promote curiosity by encouraging questions and seeking answers together.

ACHIEVE

- ▶ Support learning and celebrate success
- ▶ Establish a homework routine and a quiet space to learn.
- ▶ Communicate with teachers to understand expectations and how to support learning at home.
- ▶ Recognise accomplishments, big or small, academic or personal — growth matters.
- ▶ Encourage time management and responsibility so children learn to take ownership of their learning.
